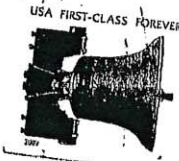
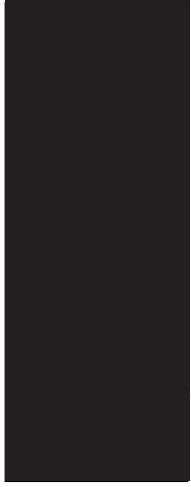



We feel to keep the form of mayor, alderman and councilor form of governance with Mayor and Aldermen justice of the peace for municipal court within the city including the writ of habeas corpus

And if we were to instigate lawful money (silver) in the city under the constitution then we will have a lawful court correctly under the constitution for in reality without lawful money we cannot have a lawful court,
